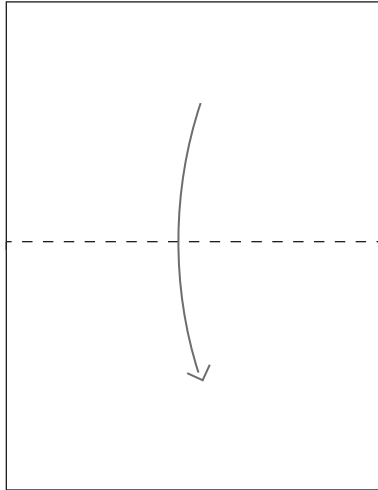
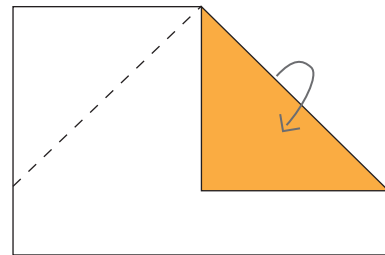


Make a fun paper hat

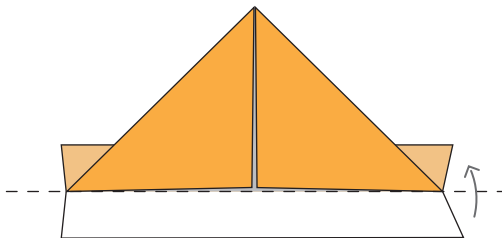
Difficulty level 1.



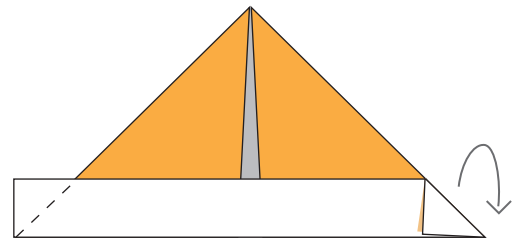
- 1 Fold a sheet of paper in half. Newspaper is a great size!



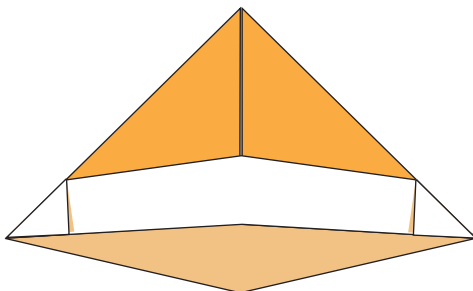
- 2 Now fold each corner into the centre.



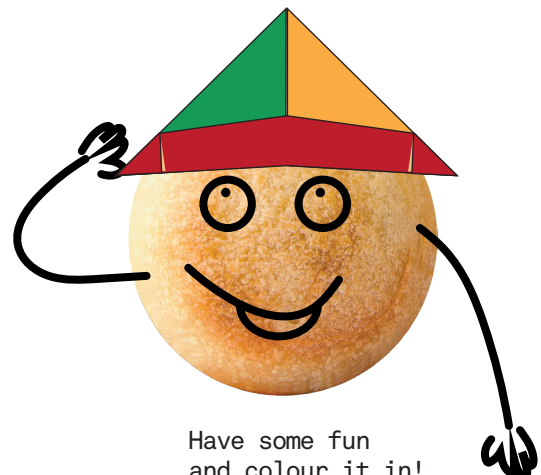
- 3 Fold the bottom pieces up along the dotted line on each side.



- 4 Fold the corner pieces over in front and press down.



- 5 Now open your hat out.

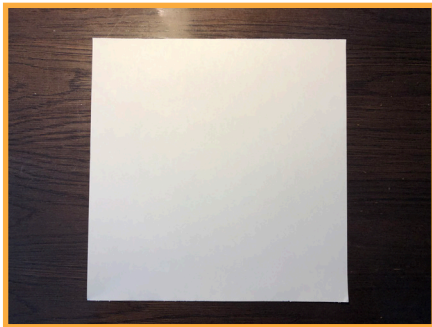

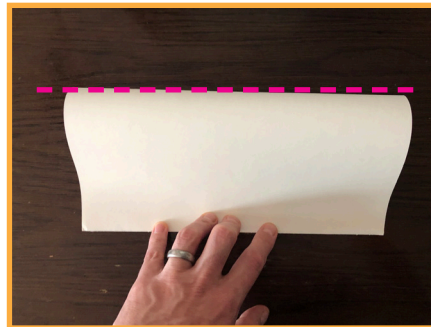
Make a Paper Pizzaiolo Hat!



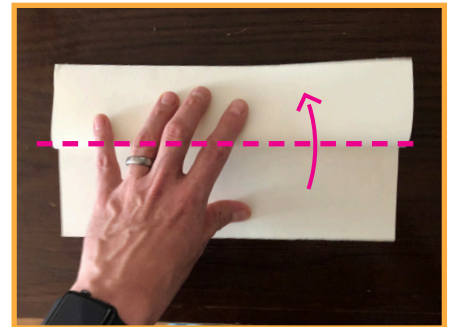
Now that you've mastered the first hat,
try moving on to a pizzaiolo hat.
Difficulty level 4/5.



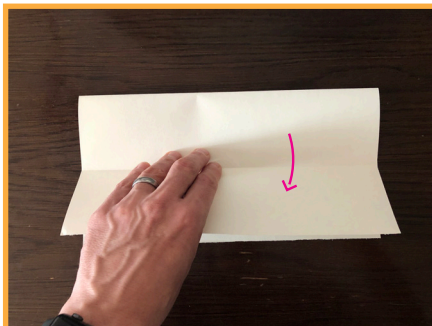
1. Take a square piece of paper.
The bigger the better.



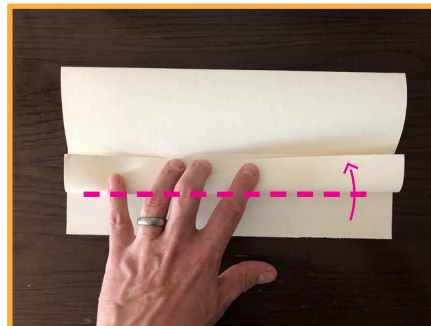
2. Fold the top down in half
and crease along dotted line.



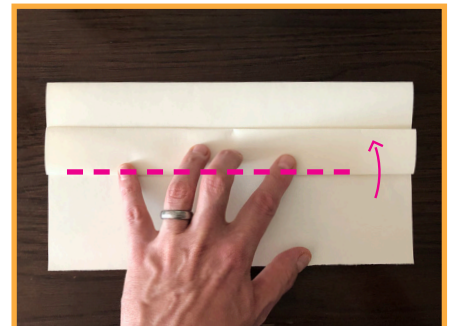
3. Fold the top piece up to half
way and crease.



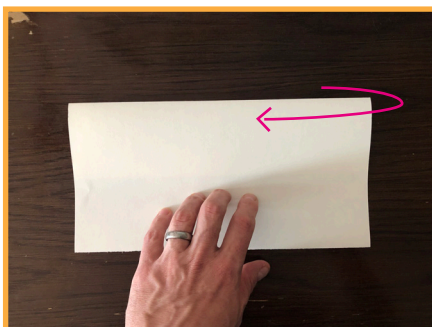
4. Then open out again.



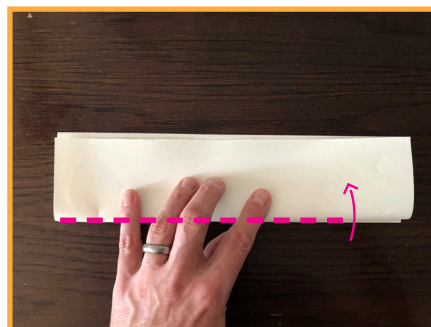
5. Now fold up along the
dotted line to the half way mark.



6. And fold that piece over again
to look like this.



7. Now flip over to the other side.



8. Fold the top side up in half to
make a crease on the dotted line.

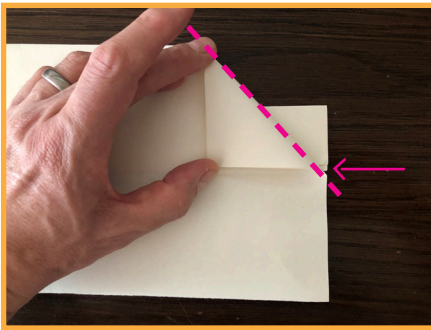


9. And then unfold.

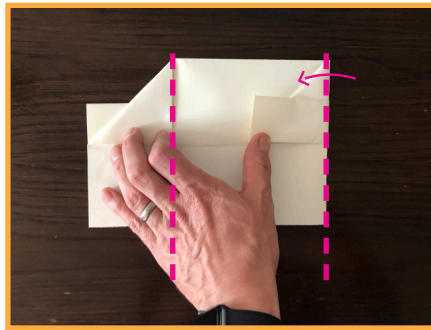

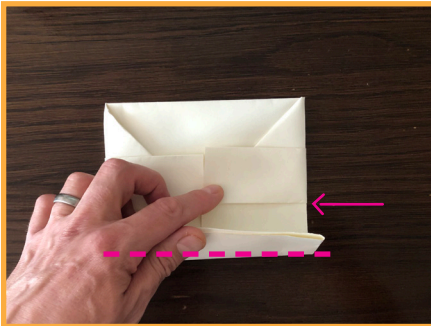
10. Now fold each front corner down as far as the crease.



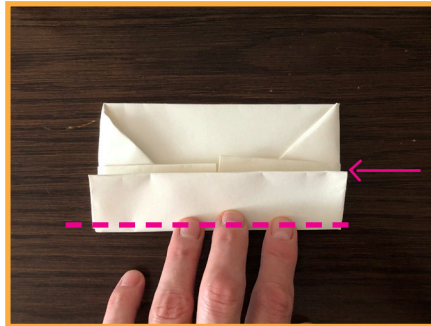
11. Fold each side in along the line of the corner.



12. They should meet in the middle like this.



13. Fold and crease along the dotted line to the arrow.



14. And fold and crease again along the dotted line to the arrow.



15. Then open out.



16. Now tuck the paper behind the flap.



17. Open the hat with your fingers inside and shape.



18. You're done. You're now a pizzaiolo!
